D'Aloisio developed his news app Summly while a GCSE student at King's College School, Wimbledon, selling it to Yahoo! for \$30m in 2013. He quit Yahoo! last year to focus on a computer science and philosophy degree at Oxford and spent the summer as Airbnb's "entrepreneur in residence". Now 20, he has invested in DeepMind, an artificial intelligence start-up. **£20m, 32=**

**CARL HARTLEY** Car sales. Hartley runs a luxury and supercar dealership with his father, Tom. In 2014 they sold a 1957 Ferrari 250 Testa Rossa for £24.1m, a world record, and that year made £4m profit on £46m sales. Carl, 28, owns half the £40m Tom Hartley operation, which is run from the family's Derbyshire estate.

**SAM SMITH** Music. Smith, 23, won an Oscar for best original song in February, for Writing's On The Wall, his theme for the Bond film, Spectre. Describing 2015 as the "best year of his life to date", Smith won two Brit awards and four Grammys. Born in London and raised in Cambridgeshire, last year he undertook an 81-date world tour – his first – which was interrupted by a six-week break after vocal-cord surgery. **£12m, 49=**
